#### 1. Navigation Bar

This bar features the logo and all section links, as well as a search bar and log in/create account links. This bar is not fixed. The logo acts as a "home" link. When a section link is hovered over, it transforms into a drop-down box with sub-section links.

#### 2. Main Article

The main article extends full-bleed on the page. On section pages, this will be the top article for that section.

#### **3. Featured Articles**


The featured articles can scroll horizontally in a scroll-wheel type motion. These are some of the most popular articles across any section.

#### 4. Footer


The footer should feature the logo, social media icons, and all relevant partner site and administrative links.







#### **3. Featured Articles**


The featured articles are displayed as a single column on mobile screens and will scroll vertically. There is a maximum of four featured articles on the home screen.
